UNITED STATES NATIONAL PARK SERVICE (www.nps.gov)

Masks are required in all US Federal Buildings regardless if vaccinated or not, this includes the National Park buildings.

Masks are required for everyone on all forms of public transportation.(04 Aug 2021)

In order to regulate the visitors flow and to ensure a smooth visit the National Park Service now requires **In addition to the regular entry fee (or Annual America the Beautiful) special entry Tickets which must be reserved in advance for :**

**Arches,
Glacier (Going to the Sun Road),
Rocky Mountain and Yosemite National Parks
Yosemite National Park
Zion National Park**

Several National Parks are implementing entry tickets for this summer which are available on the Recreation.gov website. Visitors should create an account or check access to their existing account **before tickets go on sale.**

Details vary by park, in general visitors will need three things for their visit,

- 1) entry ticket,
- 2) photo ID, and
- 3) park entrance fee OR valid park pass.

The reservation-holder must be in the vehicle with photo identification when they arrive at the park. The Timed Entry Ticket includes a \$2.00 non-refundable reservation fee which is separate from the park entrance fee.

Yosemite NP

Period requiring reservations: 20 May, 2022 – 30 September, 2022
Time requiring reservations: 6AM – 4PM Daily
Will Start taking reservations on: 23 March, 2022 (for all arrival dates, 20 May – 30 Sep)
Additional reservations available: 8AM PDT 7 days before entry (ie. For 30 Sep on 23 Sep)

Additional Info: (new) Reservations required for visitors driving on Highway 120 (via Tioga Pass) from/to Lee Vining, Mammoth Lakes, Death Valley and Las Vegas

- Reservations will be required for 20 May, 2022 to 30 September, 2022
- Visitors can book reservations first come first serve on **Recreation.gov** beginning on 23 March, 2022.
- Good for 3 consecutive days
- Reservations required for visitors even just driving on Highway 120 (via Tioga Pass)
- After entering, visitors may stay in the park as long as they wish for the remainder of the day.
- A limited number of additional reservations (30% of total) will be available for purchase **8PM PDT 7 days before entry**, through **Recreation.gov** (NOT available at the park entrance)
- For visitors who have reservations at the following lodges located in the park, reservations are NOT required
 - Ahwahnee Hotel
 - Yosemite VALLEY Lodge
 - Wawona Hotel
 - Curry Village

Arches NP

Period requiring reservations: 2 April, 2022 – 3 October, 2022

Time requiring reservations: 6AM – 5PM Daily

Will Start taking reservations on: 3 January, 2022 (3 months prior)

Additional reservations available: 6PM MDT the day before entry

- Reservations will be required for **2 April, 2022 to 3 October, 2022**
- Visitors can book reservations first come first serve on **Recreation.gov** beginning at 8AM MST (GMT-7) on 3 January, 2022.
- **The park will release reservations 3 months in advance in monthly blocks:**

3 January	3 – 20 April
1 February	1 – 31 May
1 March	1 – 30 June
1 April	1 – 31 July
1 May	1 – 31 August
1 June	1 – 31 September
1 July	1 – 3 October
- After booking a reservation, visitors will receive a Timed Entry Ticket – will be required to enter the park from 6AM to 5PM daily and will allow visitors to enter the park during a **one-hour** specified window.
- After entering, visitors may stay in the park as long as they wish for the remainder of the day.
- A limited number of additional reservations will be available for purchase **6PM MDT the day before entry**, through **Recreation.gov** (NOT available at the park entrance)
- For visitors who book the tours to Arches NP (such as by Adrift and Moab Adventure Center) are NOT required to have reservations to the park during the tours.

Glacier NP

Period requiring reservations: 27 May, 2022 – 11 September, 2022
Time requiring reservations: 6AM – 4PM Daily
Will Start taking reservations on: **2 March (120 days prior)**
Additional Reservations available: **8AM** MDT the day before entry (still TBD)

- Reservations are required from **27 May, 2022 – 11 September, 2022** for **West Entrance to access the Going-to-the-Sun-Road**. Reservations times will be for **6AM – 4PM only** – NO reservations required before 6AM and after 4PM (4PM – 6AM)
- Reservations are required from **late June (when Going-to-the-Sun-Road “GTTSR” fully opened) – 11 September, 2022** for **East Entrance at St. Marys** – until GTTSR is fully opened, visitors can proceed to Rising Sun Motor Inn area without reservations. Reservations times will be for **6AM – 4PM only** – NO reservations required before 6AM and after 4PM (4PM – 6AM)
- (NEW) Reservations are required from 27 May, 2022 – 11 September, 2022 for North Fork Entrance. This is a separate reservation from the one for GTTSR. The reservation time will be for 6AM to 6PM – NO reservations required before 6AM and after 6PM (but unlikely for international visitors to access the park from this entrance)
- Reservations are NOT required to access Many Glacier Valley (where Many Glacier Lodge and Swiftcurrent Motor Inn are located) via Many Glacier Entrance
- Visitors can book reservations first come first serve Reservations can be made **120 days** in advance on **Recreation.gov** but they have not announced how they are going to issue tickets yet – only we know is “sometimes in March”
- **Reservations are good for 3 days only (shortened from 7 days in 2021)**

- Reservations are **NOT required** for overnight guests at:
 - o Lake McDonald Lodge
 - o Village Inn at Apgar
 - o Motel Lake McDonald
 - o Rising Sun Motor Inn
- Reservations are **REQUIRED** for overnight guests at:
 - o Many Glacier Hotel
 - o Swiftcurrent Motel Inn
 - o St. Marys Lodge
 - o Glacier Park Lodge
- Limited numbers of additional reservations will be available, the details are still TBD but it will be most likely to be **ONE DAY BEFORE** in 2022 (instead of 2 days in 2021) – ie. Reservations for 16 June will become available at **8AM** on 15 June.

Rocky Mountain NP

Two types of reservations will be available:

1. For the entire park + the Bear Lake Road Corridor
2. For the entire park only (exclude the Bear Lake Road Corridor)

Period requiring reservations: 27 May, 2022 – 10 October, 2022

Time requiring reservations: 5AM – 6PM Daily (for the entire park + the Bear Lake Road corridor)
9AM – 3PM Daily (for the entire park exclude the Bear Lake)

Will Start taking reservations on: 2 May, 2022 (3 months prior)

Additional reservations available: 5PM MDT the day before entry

- Reservations will be required for **27 May, 2022 to 10 October, 2022**
- Visitors can book reservations first come first serve on **Recreation.gov** beginning at 10AM MDT (GMT-7) on 2 May, 2022.
- The park will release reservations 1 month in advance in monthly blocks:

2 May	27 May – 30 June
1 June	1 – 31 July
1 July	1 – 31 August
1 August	1 - 30 September
1 September	1 - 10 October
- After booking a reservation, visitors will receive a Timed Entry Ticket – will be required to enter the park from 5AM to 6PM daily (and will allow visitors to enter the park during a **two-hour** specified window.
- After entering, visitors may stay in the park as long as they wish for the remainder of the day.
- A limited number of additional reservations will be available for purchased **5PM MDT the day before entry**, through **Recreation.gov** (NOT available at the park entrance)

Zion NP –

During spring, summer and autumn, vehicles are not allowed in the park. A large parking spot is available at the parc's entrance and shuttles will be operated according to visitors hours, much depending on the daylight. See this website for the operating hours.

This is only for the hike to Angels Landing – no reservations are required to get into the park (at least this has not been announced yet)

Period requiring permits: from 1 April, 2022 – all year
Time requiring permits: all day
Started taking reservations on: 3 January
Additional permits available: Between 12:01AM – 3:00PM on the day before

- On and after 1 April, 2022 – going to Angels Landing will require a permit – a different system from “reservations”
- The National Park Service (NPS) will issue permits using ONLINE LOTTERIES at Recreations.gov
- There are two ways: the advance lottery/permit and the day-before permit
-
- **The park will release reservations 1 month in advance in three-month blocks:**

3 January	1 April – 31 May (FULL)
1 – 20 April	1 June – 31 August (lottery winners notified on 25 April)
1 – 20 July	1 September – 30 November (lotter winners notified on 25 July)
1 – 20 October	1 December – 28 February, 2023 (lotter winners notified on 25 October)
- If successful, a confirmation email them serves as the permit will be send to the permit holder
- An electronic or paper copy of the confirmation email must be carried while on your hike (mobile phone service in the park is very limited – paper copy recommended)
- The permits are valid for a single day for a group size up to 6 people
- People applying multiple times as permit holder will have their lottery applications canceled without refund.

Tunnel Traffic Control for Oversize Vehicles

Before 1989, large vehicles, including tour buses, motor homes, and trailers, were involved in more and more accidents and near misses in the tunnel due to an immense increase in the

volume of traffic and in the size of vehicles passing through the tunnel.

A study by the Federal Highways Administration in early 1989 found that large vehicles could not negotiate the curves of the tunnel without crossing the center line. To ensure safety, the National Park Service began traffic control at the tunnel in the spring of that year.

Rangers posted at both ends of the tunnel convert two-way tunnel traffic to one-way for larger vehicles, ensuring safe passage.

This service, for which a \$15 dollar tunnel permit fee is charged, was provided for over 32,832 oversized oversized vehicles in calendar year 2019.

In 2022 large vehicles may only travel through the tunnel daily from:

- February 27 to March 12 from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m
- March 13 to April 23 from 8:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.
- April 24 to August 27 from 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.
- August 28 to September 24 from 8:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.
- September 25 to November 5 from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m
- Starting November 6, winter hours of operations for the tunnel are 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

- **NAVAJO NATION PARKS & RECREATION**

Monument Valley Tribal Park, UT

All Navajo Tribal Parks including Monument Valley, Four Corners, Antelope Canyon, Lake Powell, Canyon de Chelly and Little Colorado River have reopened. There is mask mandate; everyone 2 years and over will be required to wear a mask while on the Navajo Reservation, even vaccinated people. (12 July 2021)
